

Applying for a Student ePermit (Hunter St)

Use the digital permit system (DPS) to apply for your student ePermit and to manage your account. You can also use it to update the details of the car you're bringing to campus, if needed.

If approved, your ePermit is valid until the **end of the calendar year**.

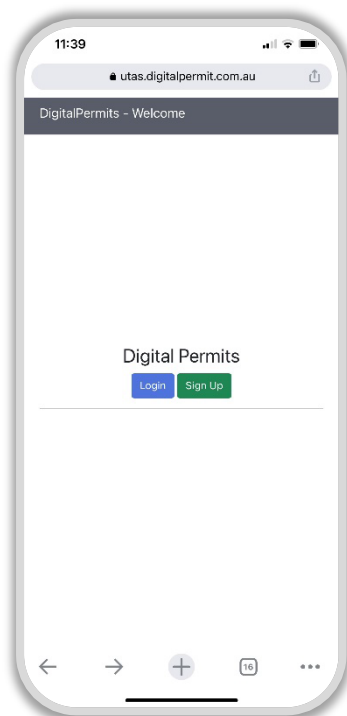

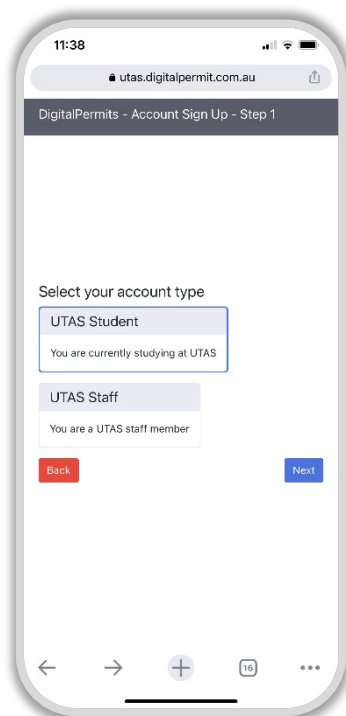

Getting started: New to the system?

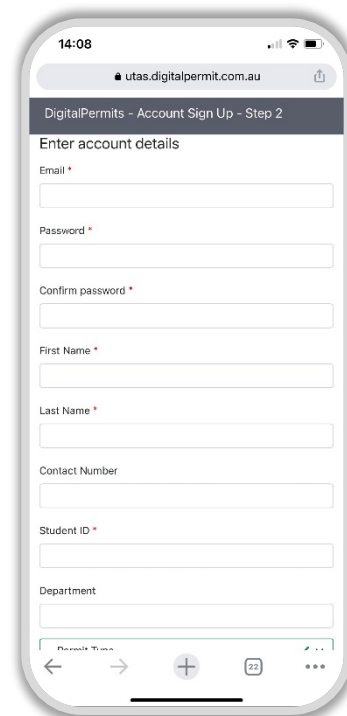
You'll need to set up a new account.



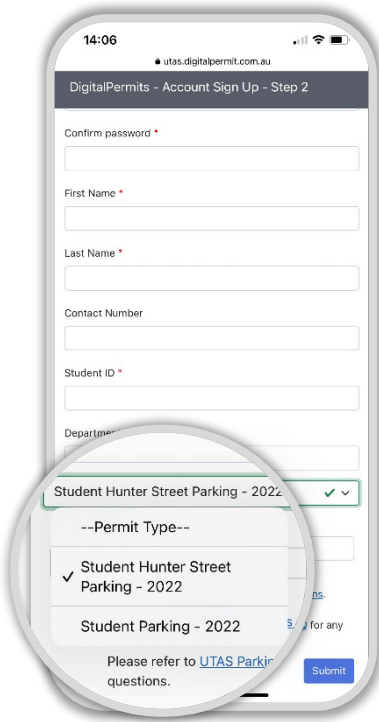
1. Tap **Sign Up** on the DPS page.



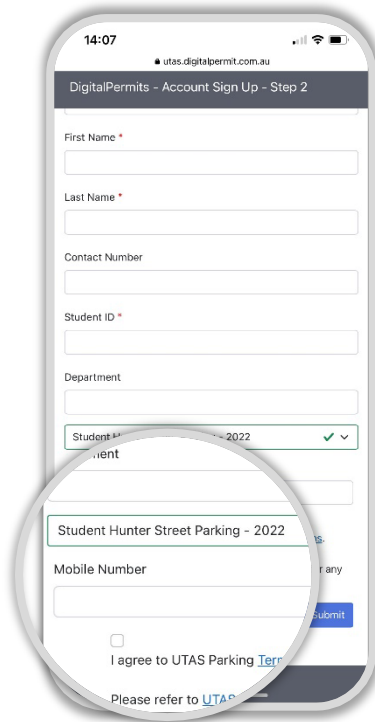
2. Select **UTAS Student** as your account type



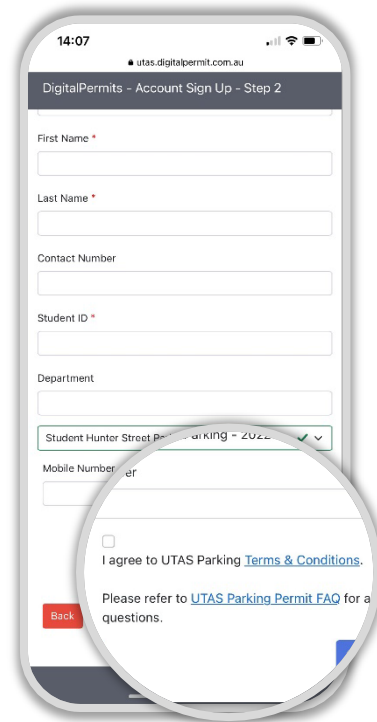
3. Enter your account details. Use your **UTAS email address** as your username



4. Choose your **Permit Type**.



5. Input your **mobile phone number**.



6. Check the box to agree to the Terms & Conditions and hit **Submit**.

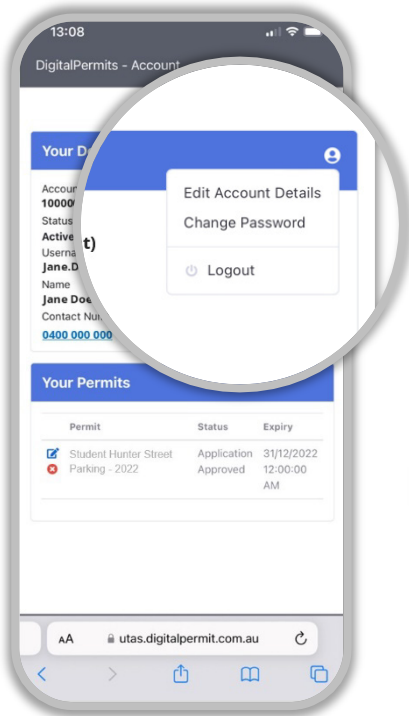
Things to remember when setting up your account →

- 1 Use your **full University email address** as your username
 - > Non-university emails won't be accepted
- 2 Your **password** must contain:
 - > at least six (6) letters
 - > one (1) non-numeric character
- 3 You must give us your **mobile number**
 - > This **must** be the same as the number you use for your EasyPark payment app
- 4 We'll need your **8-digit Student ID** to confirm you're eligible
- 5 Only **CAM students located at Hunter Street** are eligible for this ePermit
 - > There's a specific approval process. Please don't apply if you're not eligible
- 6 You're issued with an **interim ePermit** while we process your application
 - > You can park in the voucher parking zone at the Hunter Street carpark
- 7 By applying for an ePermit, you're agreeing to be bound by our **Terms and Conditions**
- 8 If everything's in order, once you hit **Submit** you'll get an approval email in 5 working days

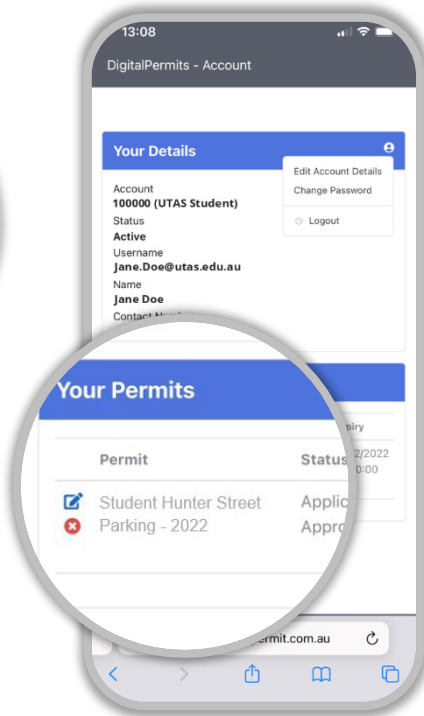
Making changes to your account

Once you're set up, you can log back in at any time to:

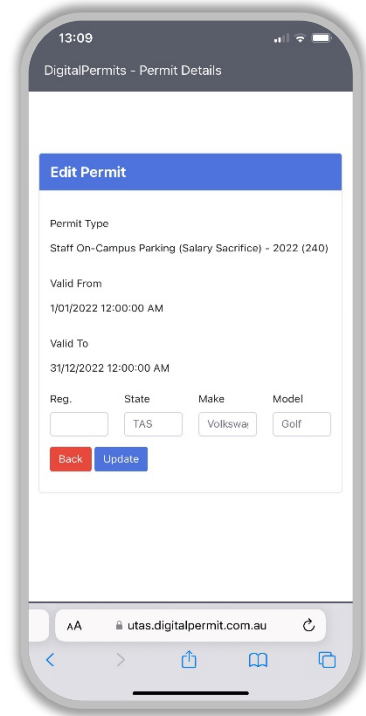
- > review and/or edit your **personal details**
- > **cancel** your permit



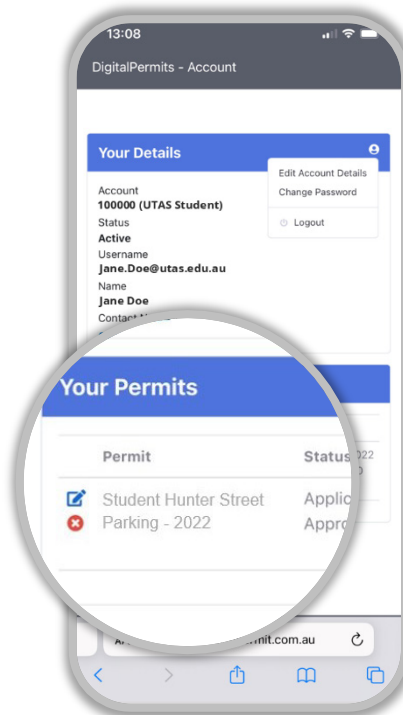
1. To edit your **account details**, hit the user icon (top right) & choose from the options.
